## **Leave at Home**

Camping is a way of life. Camp Latgawa requires that you leave home those things that would detract from your camp experience such as: **CELL PHONES**, radios, MP3 players (I-Pods) or handheld games. **I-Pods and cell phones may NOT be used as a camper's camera or watch.** If you bring these items they will be held by the camp's directors until the end of camp.

Campers should not bring food to camp as it may attract unwanted critters.

## **About Mail**

**LETTERS** to campers should be sent in the mail at least one week in advance; letters may also be left with the directors when dropping off your camper.

**PACKAGES** for campers are welcome if dropped off at the beginning of camp. Packages should contain NO food items. **Please do not mail packages to your camper.** Because of our rural location, the post office does not have a secure place to leave packages at the Latgawa mailbox.
